# About Salzburg

## GOOD REASONS FOR SALZBURG

Salzburg is a safe and beautiful city. Although it is not large, Salzburg offers excellent infrastructure. There are lots of good reasons that make it easy to choose Salzburg.

### Good reason no.1: Safety

Salzburg is a small city at home in the world. Austria is a neutral, sovereign state at the heart of the European Union. Low crime rates combined with extreme political stability, both domestically and in foreign affairs, make Austria a very safe place to be. Strikes are also very rare in Austria.

Salzburg Congress belongs to Tourismus Salzburg GmbH (TSG) which is owned 100% by the municipal authorities of Salzburg. The city owes its fame, to a significant degree, to Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, the Salzburg Festival, its old baroque-style town, 'The Sound of Music' and several other people of world repute. The city environment offers a fascinating mix of historical architecture punctuated by examples of modernity, and the venue also benefits aesthetically from this contrast.

Austria is well known for its standards of service provision.

## Good reason no.3: Central location

Salzburg Congress is situated in the centre of the town, just a few minutes' walk from the historical quarter. Guests at Salzburg Congress meet in the heart of the city of Salzburg. The large full-surface window facades provide a clear view of Schloss Mirabell palace and the adjacent garden, of Mönchsberg Hill – home of the Museum der Moderne, and across to the roofs of the old town – which has now been a UNESCO world heritage site for the last 20 years. The River Salzach is just five minutes' walk away, and another five minutes take guests into the Getreidegasse – to Mozart's birthplace, the cathedral square and the Residenz palace. There are lots of great places to shop and stroll here, and several marvellous old coffee shops.

Geographically, the city of Salzburg is right at the centre of Austria. It is close to the German border and boasts highly-developed, well-integrated traffic and transport links.

## Good reason no.4: A large range of hotels

There is a large and comprehensive range of hotels in all categories in Salzburg and the surrounding villages. As home of the Salzburg Festival, the city can provide a considerable selection of 3, 4 and 5-star hotels, including international hotels such as the Sheraton, Ramada, NH Hotels, Mercure and Best Western. There are also several boutique, old town and design hotels, as well as privately-owned hotel accommodation – all of which provide charming accommodation alternatives.

There are around 1200 hotel rooms in the immediate vicinity of the Salzburg Congress building, all of which are within walking distance.

There are no large distances to navigate within the city: Salzburg Congress can be reached by road from the airport in just 15 minutes. From here it's only a 15-minute walk to the railway station or a relaxing 10-minute stroll to the old town of Salzburg.

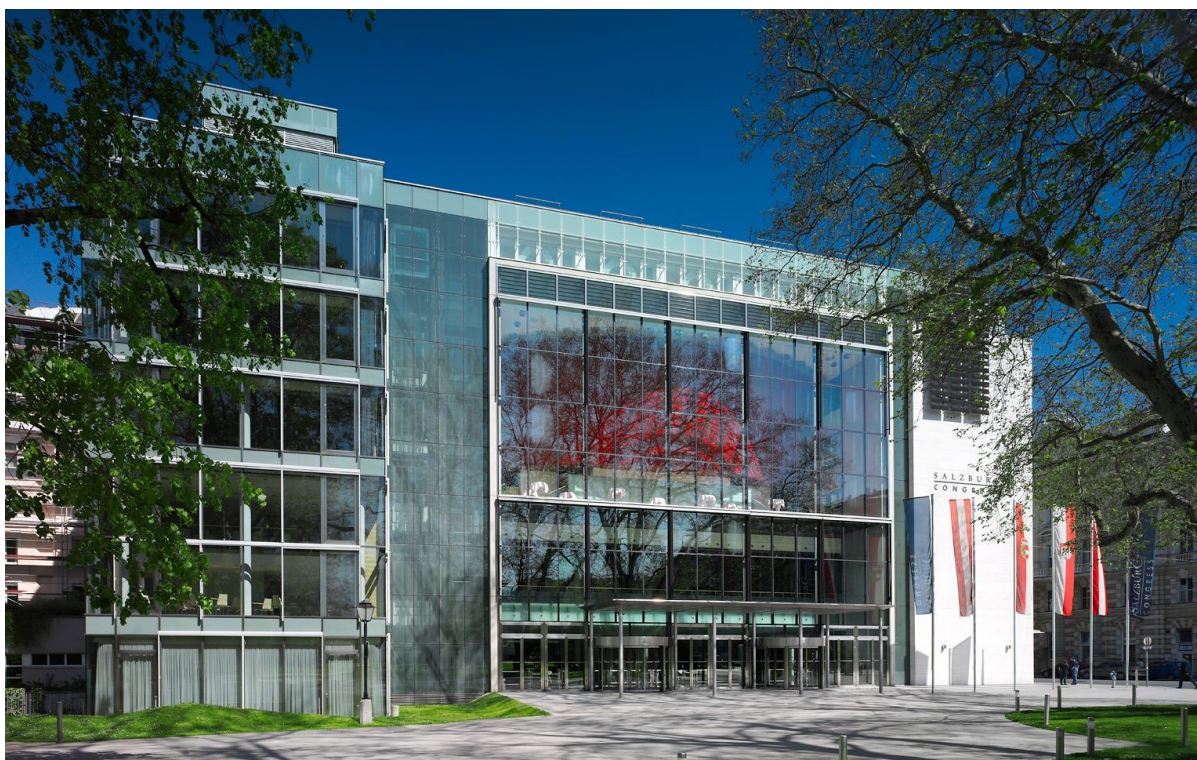

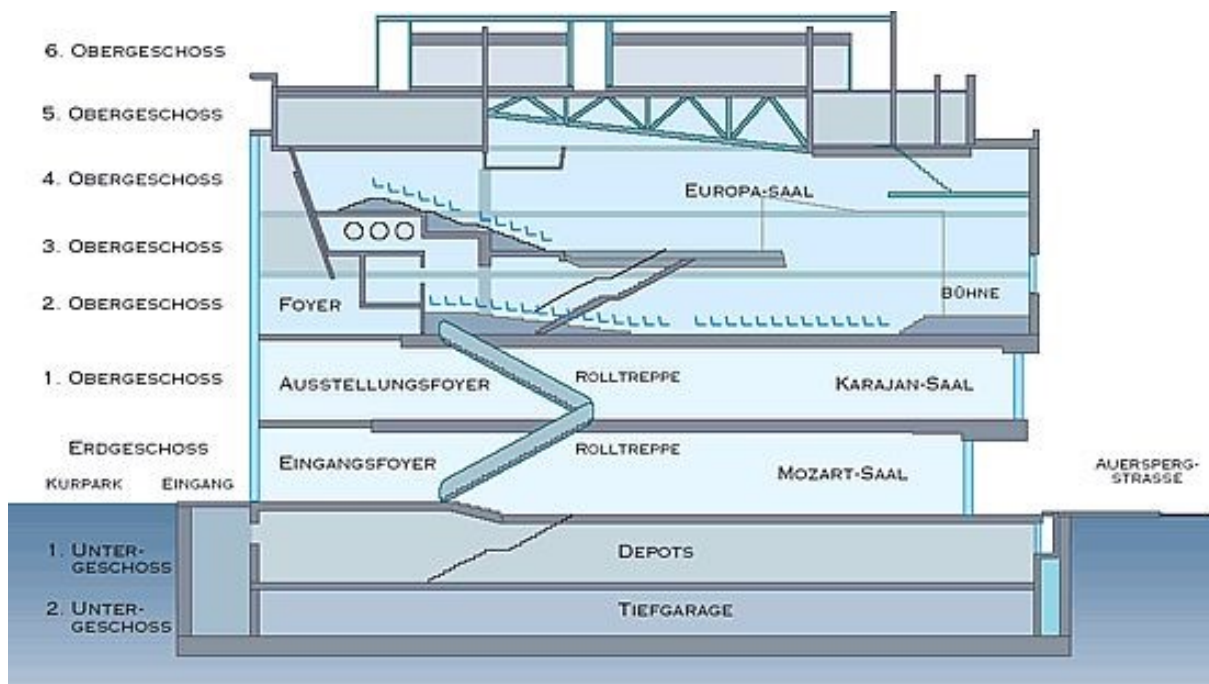

The Mozart Saal is the second-largest hall at the venue and can accommodate between 60 and 480 people. A wide variety of seating formats is available, and versatility in terms of space distribution is guaranteed by mobile dividing walls to ensure the greatest possible degree of freedom. The 548 m<sup>2</sup> entrance foyer can be integrated in your planning and used in combination for a number of purposes. The Mozart Saal is equipped with a broadband screen and two projectors. At larger events there is direct access to the technical infrastructure of the Europa Saal, so even on the ground floor you're at the heart of the action!



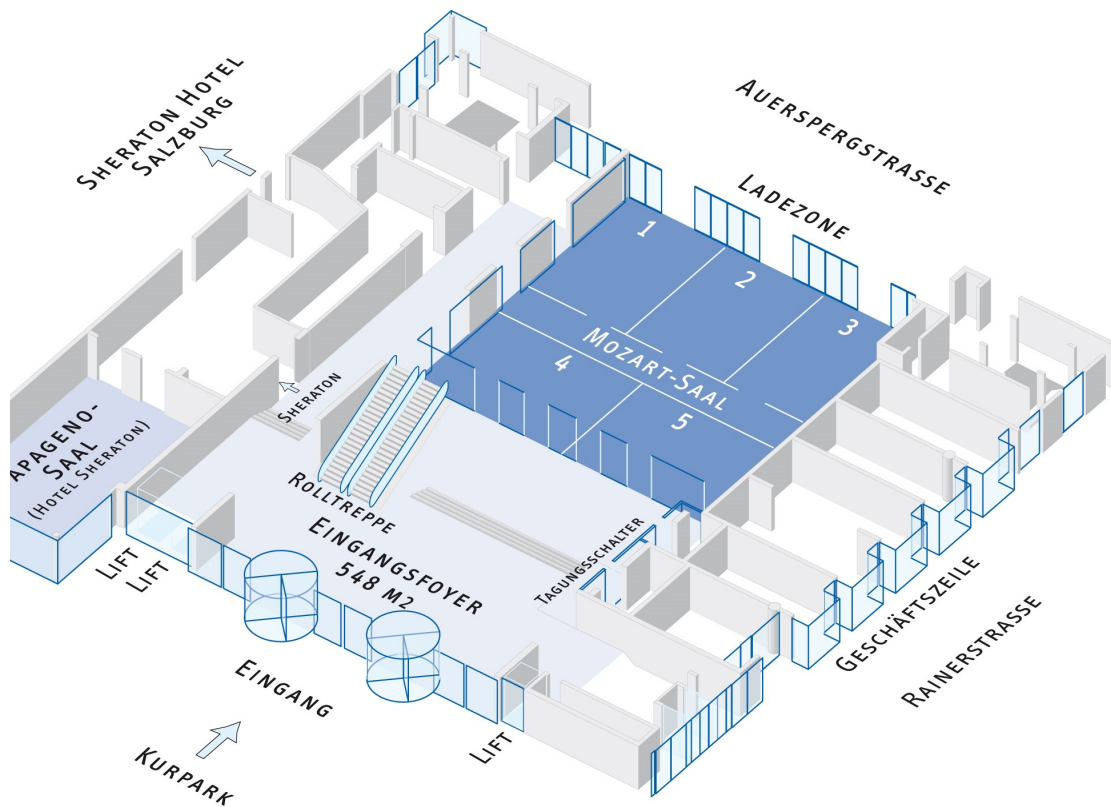

## KARAJAN SAAL

The 294 m<sup>2</sup> Karajan Saal on the first floor of Salzburg Congress can be adapted to serve a whole range of events with a wide variety of seating formats, including theatre, classroom and banquet seating.

The Karajan Saal the third-largest conference room at Salzburg Congress and its potential for transformability is almost unlimited. Mobile walls and a seamless link to the adjacent exhibition foyer yield options for several sophisticated and detailed solutions.

The venue can be divided into two halls – one with 94m<sup>2</sup> and the other with 104m<sup>2</sup> - or can be used as one single hall that offers 294m<sup>2</sup>, accommodating up to 324 guests. 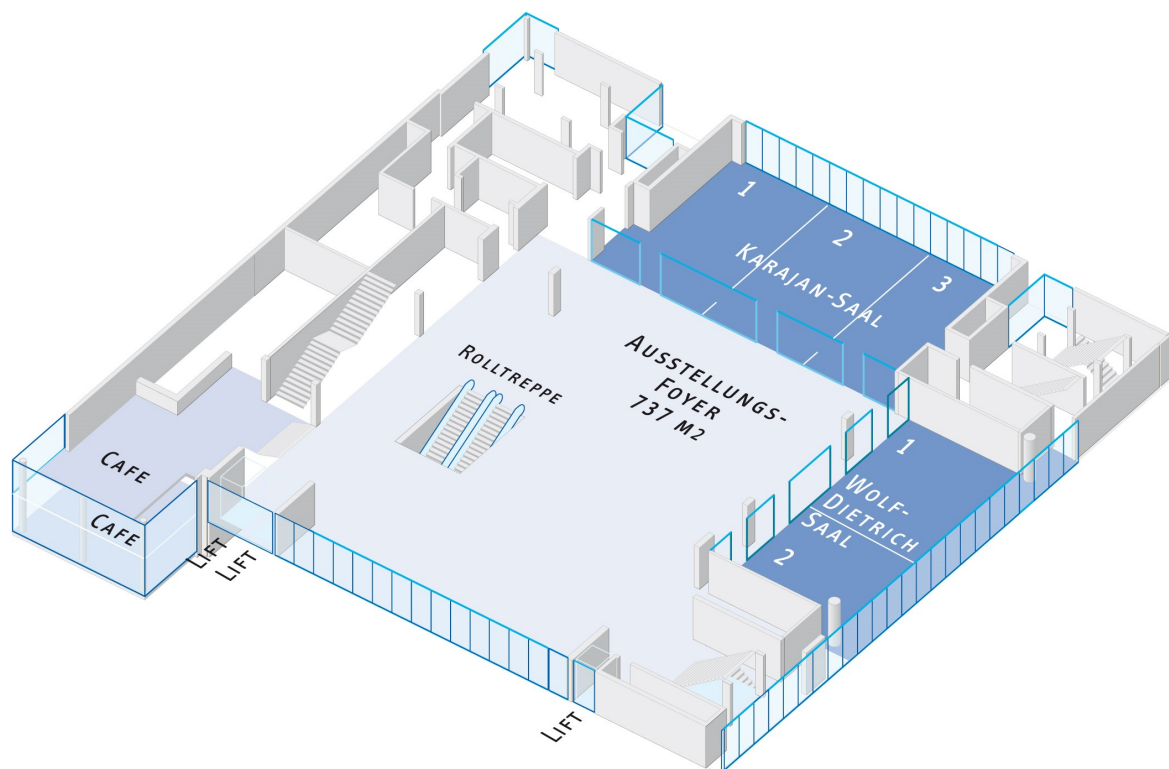

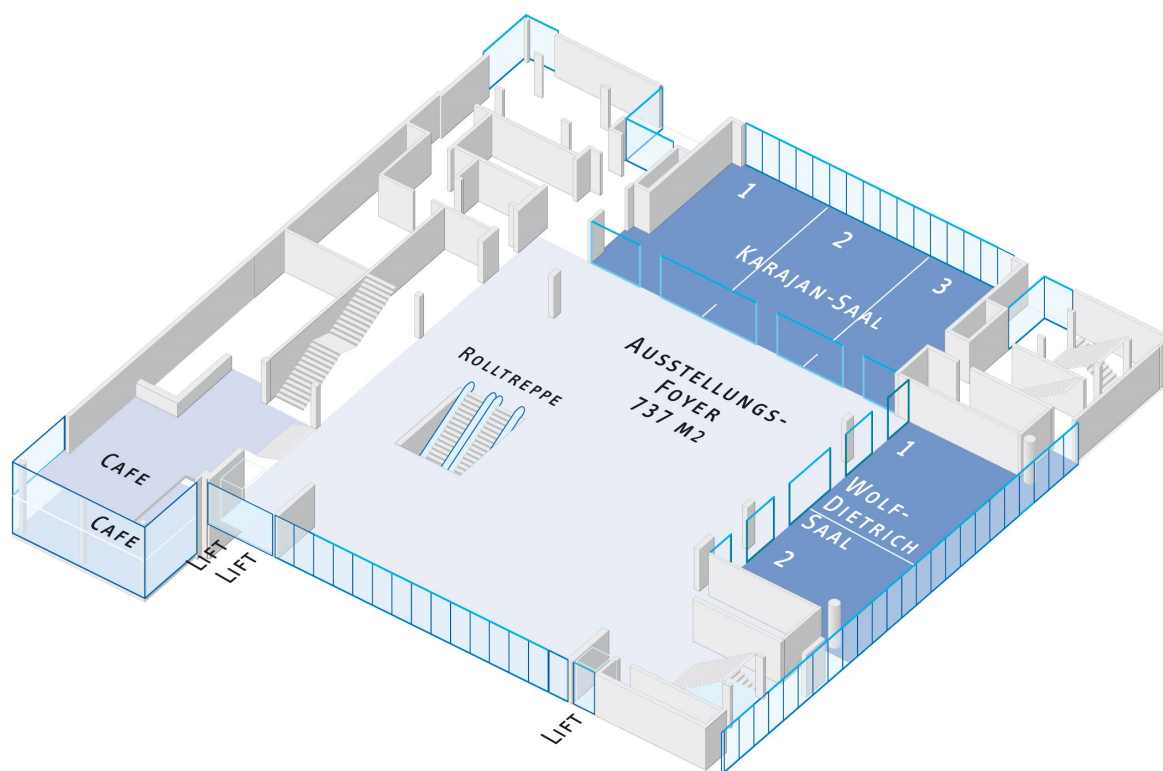

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## EUROPA SAAL

The Europa Saal is the largest venue at Salzburg Congress and forms the centrepiece of the facility. It can accommodate up to 1324 people and is equipped with ultra-modern event and presentation technology.

Whether you are hosting a congress, conference, banquet, a play or a TV show – no other location in Salzburg can compete with the Europa-Saal in terms of size, equipment and variability. The 1100m<sup>2</sup> Europa Saal is the largest and most impressive venue in the entire building. The segmented lift podiums enable the seating rows to be increasingly raised toward the rear, as in conventionally-built theatres, or for all rows to be kept at the same level. The stage size can also be varied as required.

The Europa Saal is an impressive venue reminiscent of a ship's hull. The formidable interior focuses attention due to its clear design, the sophistication of the materials used, a complete lack of in-house congress branding and the use of simple colour codes. When planning your event, the Europa Saal provides a perfect tabula rasa.



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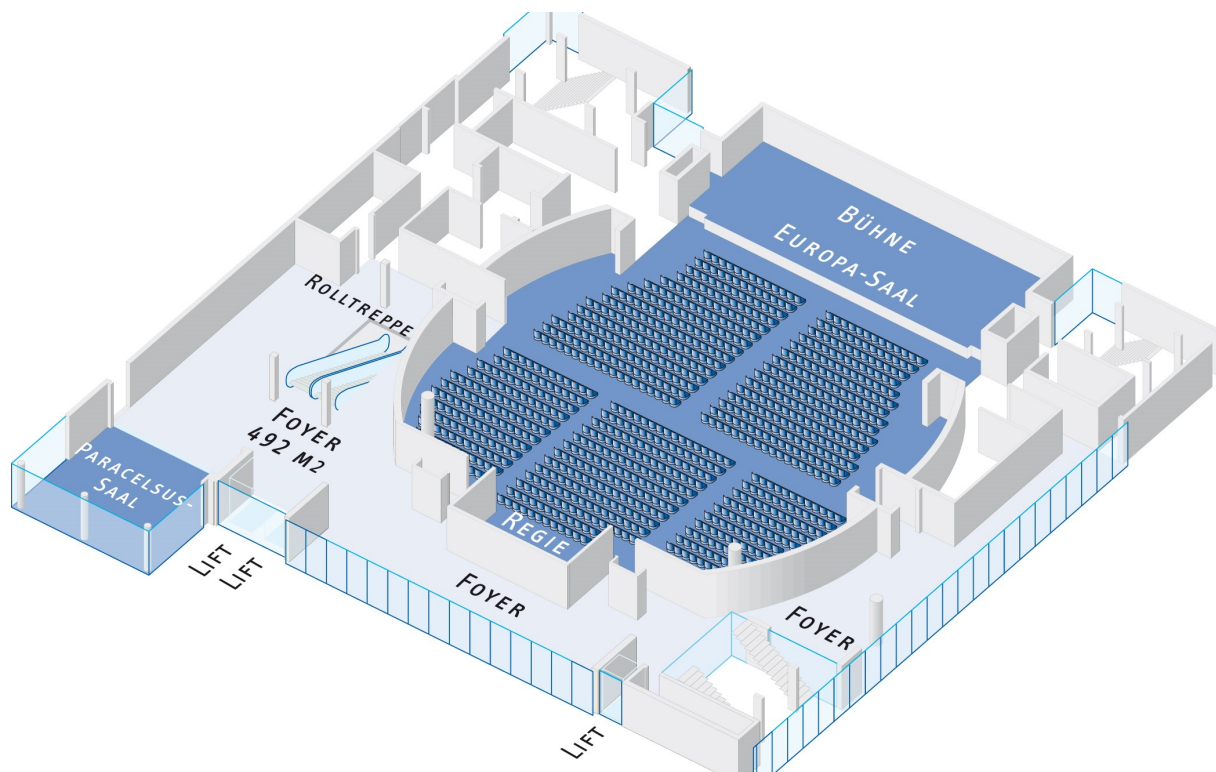

- A small foyer at the front of the hall provides space for small-scale catering set-ups and break-time gatherings.

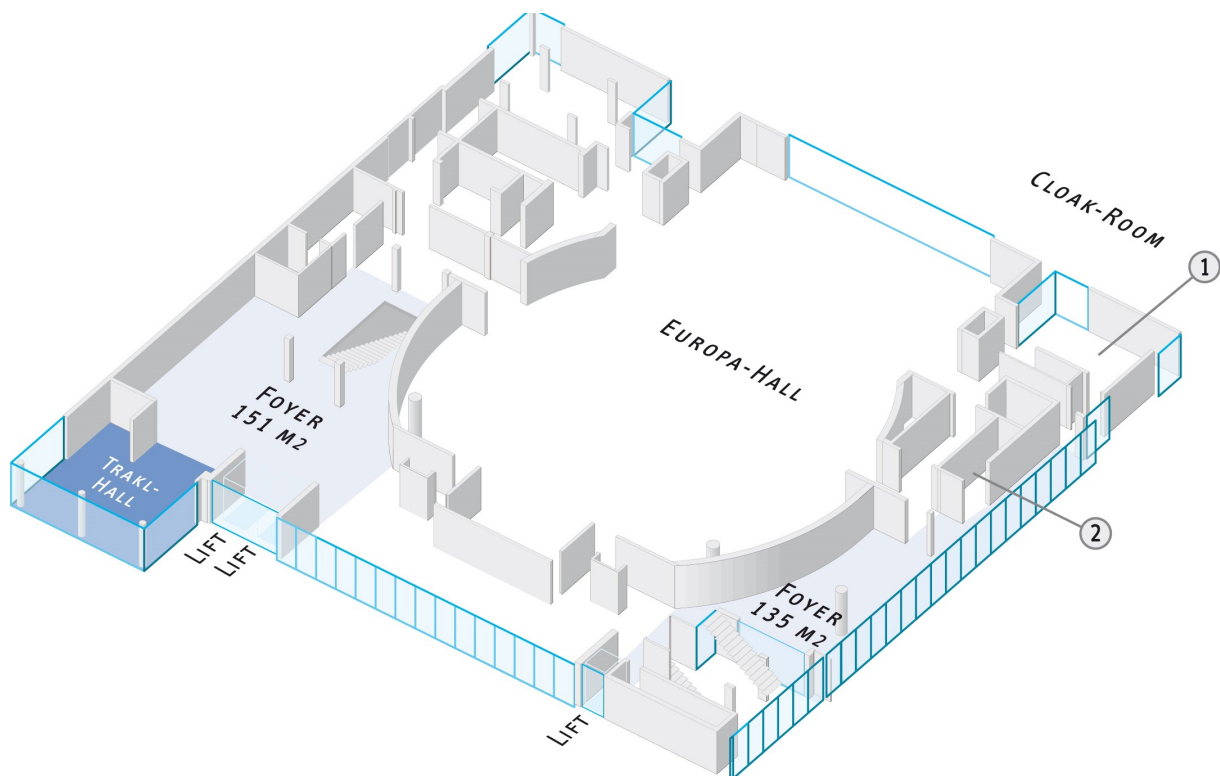

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## DOPPLER SAAL

The Doppler Saal on the fourth floor offers 120 sqm of floor space and is very popular with organisers of sophisticated meetings, in particular for the degree of privacy it offers.

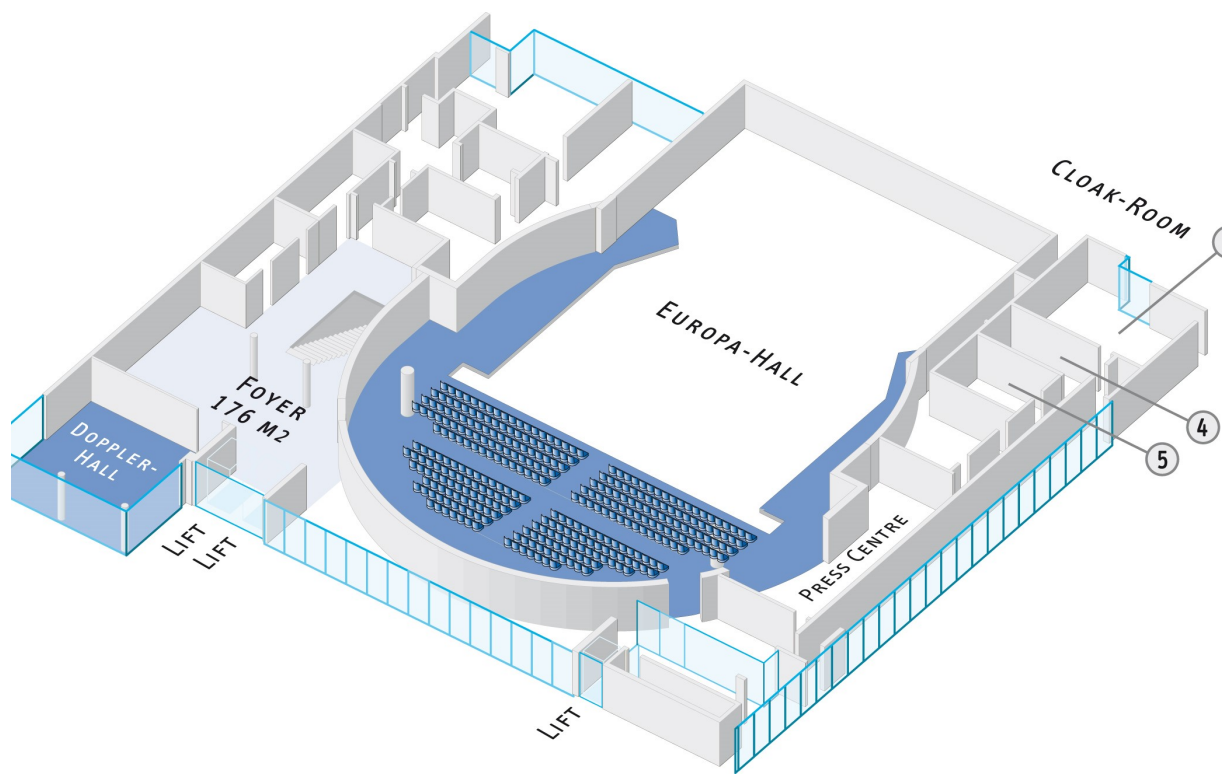

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## EXHIBITION FOYER

The route via the escalator goes from the ground floor straight into the exhibition foyer on the 1st floor. The foyer can be integrated into the Karajan Saal and Wolf-Dietrich Saal, or it can be used as a separate area for product presentations and poster displays.

The large exhibition foyer offers plenty of space for a wide range of functions and provides abundant options for implementing your own designs and ideas to maximise the number of guests frequenting the area. It is ideal for poster presentations, exhibitions, coffee breaks and welcoming receptions, since it receives plenty of natural light and offers an uninterrupted and seamless 737 m<sup>2</sup> of floor space.

Two wide-view lifts and an escalator ensure the large exhibition foyer can be reached very quickly from the main entrance. The direct accessibility of the foyer via the payload lift for deliveries, for build-up, build-down and for catering purposes, makes it an ideal choice for organisers and exhibitors. The modern stainless-steel ceiling artfully casts the light back into the room. Another eye-catching feature is guaranteed by the Swarovski crystal lamps and lights, created and constructed especially for Salzburg Congress.

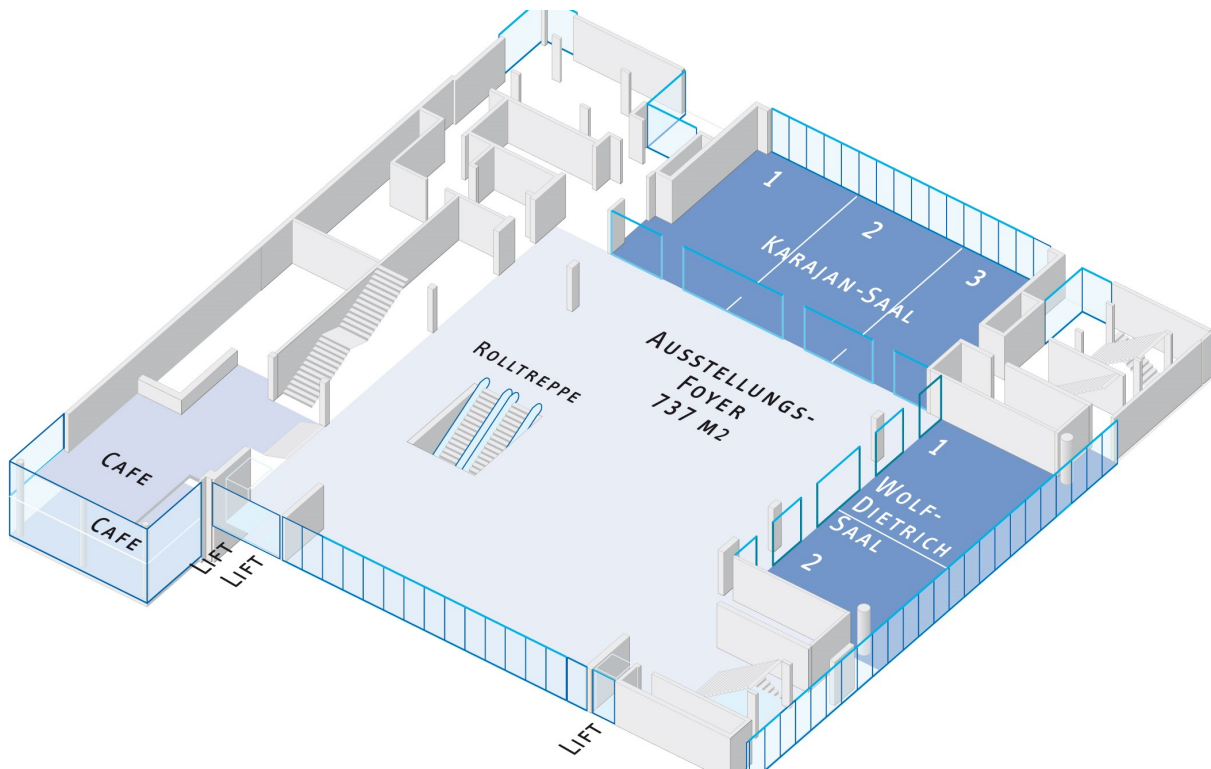

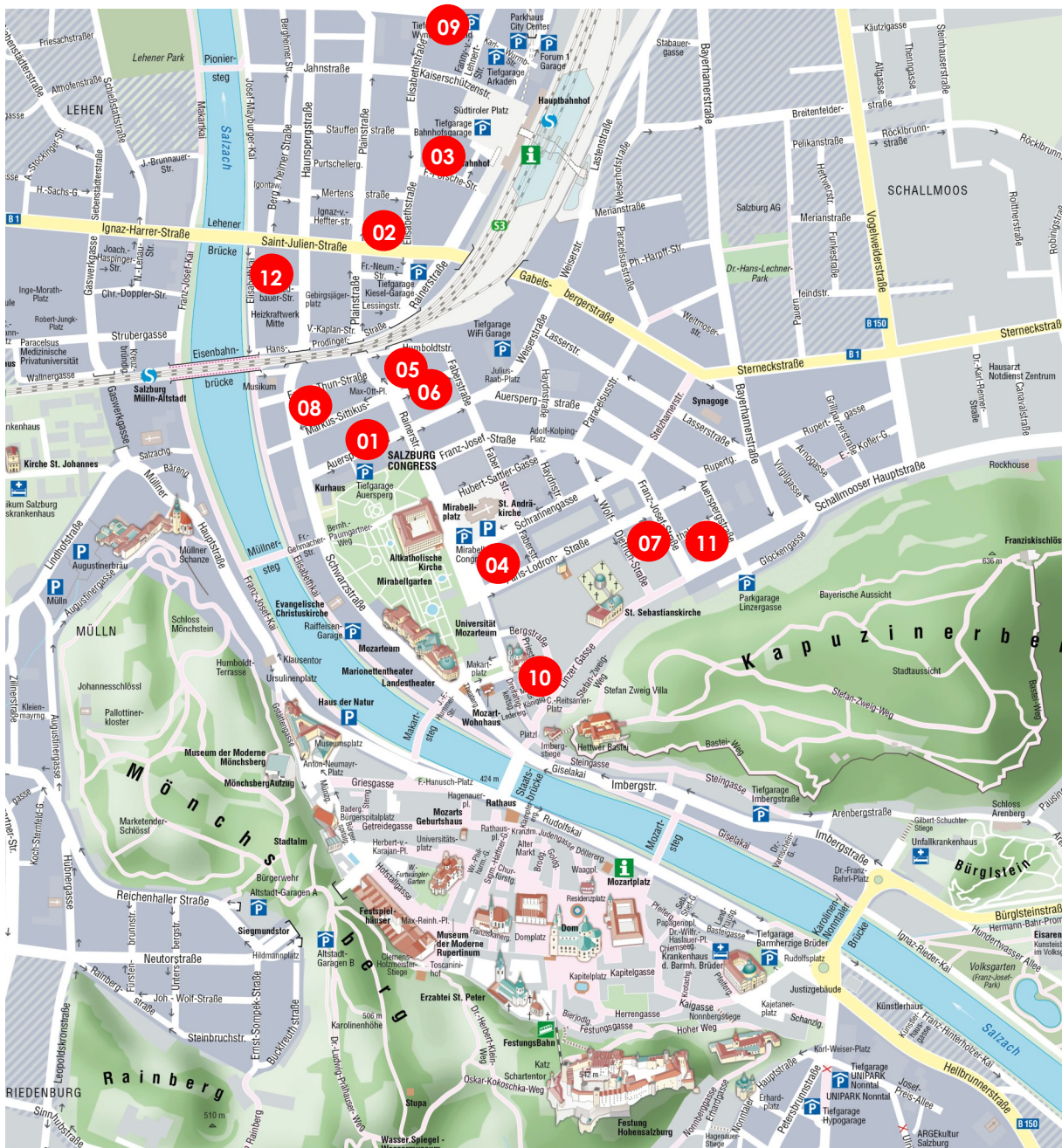

## RESIDENCE PALACE OF SALZBURG

The largest hall is the 580m<sup>2</sup> Carabinieri Saal and the smallest venue is the Antecamera, offering 100m<sup>2</sup> of floor space.

## ST. PETER'S MONASTERY RESTAURANT

### Tradition, history, modernity and the spirit of the modern age

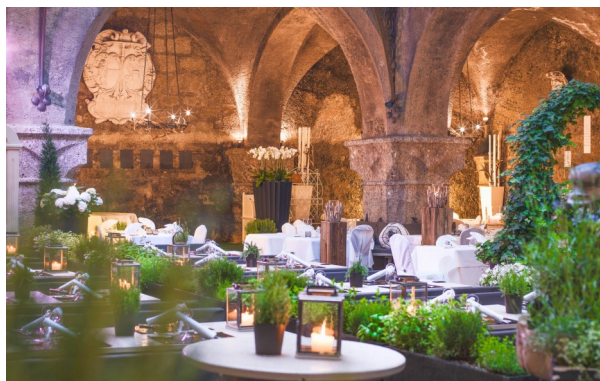
The special atmosphere exuded by this historical restaurant within old monastery walls is what lends St. Peter's Stiftskulinarium its unique and distinctive character.
